Leaner cattle were harder to sell today but there were still plenty of headliners, as long as they were properly finished. With the price of store cattle going through the roof it pays to hang on to what you've got and feed them a week or two more!

A small steer sample saw a top of 368p/kg with heavies to £2338.96.

Heifers sold to a high of 410p/kg with four cattle over or at 400p/kg. Heavy females to £2643.

Bulls were a mixed bag and sold to 352p/kg on two occasions with heavy bulls to £2604.

Nine cull cows were in strong demand saw Holsteins selling to 198p/kg for 726kg (£1437.48).

Mrs B sold two bulls to 350p/kg for 744kg Angus (£2604) and 614kg Belted Galloway x Limousin. Heavy bulls topped at £2739.30 for 794kg Limousins from Peter Kirton. An average of 336p/kg, a reflection of quality rather than the trade. Finished hoggs weighing up to 47kg the order of the day, to a top of annoyingly 398p/kg for 43kg from Rhys Perkins. 10 pens over 370p/kg with the commercial hoggs 345p/kg to 355p/kg. Leaner sheep and hoggs under 40kg sold to 346p/kg for 34kg Texels from Dave Green.

Some very impressive averages, 52 hoggs averaged 44.5kg and 363p/kg from Pete Morris; 30 hoggs averaged 42.5kg and 369p/kg from Rhys Perkins and several consignments of heavier hoggs averaging towards £170 per head.
