Numbers were tight once again and trade was sharp although anything with meat and an element of finish in demand. Cattle sold to over £3000 and an overall market average of 387p/kg.

A small sample of steers sold to 400p/kg on two occasions with heavies to £2872 in the lump.

Some smart heifers penned saw a high of 452p/kg but with several more commercial types over 400p/kg. Few heavier females sold to a high of £2599.

The bull trade started things off well with heavies past 400p/kg to 406p/kg and £3150 in the lump.

2 cull cows saw Blue cross cows to 205p/kg for 752kg.

Hoggs nationally a little easier at the end of last week with customers reporting reduced demand and trade very price reactive, possibly an aftershock of the time of year.

Today 1507 hoggs penned and an average of 344p/kg selling to 398p/kg. A good day was had by all which, with a different outcome yesterday, everyone associated with our industry would have felt sick. Unfortunately, some officials associated with all our livelihoods are quite detached from the day to day operation of our industry. Rant over!!

Peter Morris topped the sale at 398p/kg for 45kg Beltex and £188.70 for 51kg Texels from Richard Morgan.

Generally hoggs up to 46kg would easily trade between 345p/kg and 360p/kg with the top quality to just shy of 400p/kg. Hoggs over 50kg now realising discounted pence per kilo. Suddenly 40kg hoggs are worth as much as a 50kg hogg.
