63 PRIME CATTLE

Numbers were very tight today, despite Martin Clack's flying trade last Tuesday! A distinct lack of butcher's heifers with mainly heavier breaking cattle penned. A rip-roaring trade from start to finish, with heifers past £3000 and bulls to £3500.

A small entry of steers saw dairy Blues selling to £2580 with nothing past 400p/kg. Heifers topped at 478p/kg or £3005 in the lump.

Dried bagged cows with meat sold to 308p/kg or £2162.16 for 702kg British Blue, with 644kg Herefords to 300p/kg.

8 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 380P/KG

594kg Limmie crosses from Chris Jones topped here at 392p/kg with his 31-month Limmie to 390p/kg for 618kg. 688kg British Blue crosses from Brian & Dave Whiteman sold to £2580 or 375p/kg. 594kg Herefords sold to 388p/kg from Roger Rowson.

41 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 407P/KG

Roger Jordin's run of three was headed by his Blue heifer at 584kg realising 478p/kg or £2791.52 and was closely followed by handyweight Lims and Blondes from the Dalton stable, both making 470p/kg with their third to 458p/kg. Heavy females sold to £3004.68 for 686kg Limousin from Clare Burgoyne, who sold eleven heifers to average £2820.

14 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 410P/KG

A super trade here with some Limousin aces from John Hewitt both 750kg selling to 467p/kg and 452p/kg (£3502.50 and £3390 respectively). Super quick Limmies from Andrew Preece "raced" to 452p/kg for 580kg. Simmentals sold to 438p/kg at 596kg from Andrew Bryan.

SFI Announcement

On the 11th March 2025 the Rural Payments Agency announced that the Sustainable Farming Incentive scheme was closed for new applications with immediate effect. Those with existing SFI schemes will not be affected, and those with applications already submitted should still be offered an agreement, however going forward no new applications can be submitted. A reformed SFI scheme is set to be announced in the summer, but at this stage we are unsure of the exact timing or form of the scheme, but will keep you informed.
