Decent numbers of clean cattle forward once again saw trade holding its own, even though the large abattoirs took money out of beef cattle on Monday morning! Plenty of well-meated types penned, which helped buyers fulfil orders. 25 plus cattle sold at 300p/kg or above today.

A small show of steers saw a shapey sort selling to 320p/kg with heavyweights to £2217.42. Females topped at 346p/kg with £2010 top call here.

Only 1 cull cow sold well to 156p/kg for 652kg Fleckviehcross. Some well-presented bulls forward sold to a high of 300p/kg for sucklers and to £2020 in the lump. Black and whites sold to 239p/kg for 522kg.
