### 81 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers forward – a combination of more clean cattle but fewer bulls. Trade a little lethargic with wholesalers needing the cattle less money they say! Cattle without shape and too lean proved tricky with neither sorts easier to place. Please book your cattle in prior to Tuesdays so that the auctioneer is able to advise buyers of numbers.

A decent show of steers saw nothing over 400p/kg and a high of 390p/kg. Heavier steers sold to £2758 in the lump.

Handyweight butchers' heifers reached 438p/kg with three others 430p/kg. Not too many heavy females, which added up to £2456.

A mixed sample of bulls saw a high of 382p/kg for Continentals or £2781 in the lump. Less shapey types were less money.

Three cull cows saw young slip Limmies selling to 328p/kg for 624kg, with British Blue crosses to 230p/kg for 672kg and Simmental crosses 228p/kg for 736kg.

#### 15 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 360P/KG

Mrs B shone here with her 650kg Limousin selling to 390p/kg and her 726kg Limmie both to 380p/kg (£2758.80). Third spot went to Evans Curdale with their 714kg red Lim selling to 378p/kg (£2698.52)
