A small harvest entry with clean cattle particularly in short supply. Trade was pretty firm throughout with some northern marts cheaper yesterday? The entry today was a real credit to our suppliers with hardly a clean beast in the place. It is great to see people making the best of their cattle.

Our steer entry included some tidy cattle which sold to 422p/kg with heavies just short of £3000.

A small show of heifers saw a market high of 442p/kg with 13 females 400p/kg or more with heavies just below £2900.

Plenty of heavy, fit bulls saw a firm trade also selling to 404p/kg with heavies to £3017 in the lump.

#### 15 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 377P/KG

A useful sample was topped by Mrs B's Limmie at 624kg, reaching 422p/kg, with a shapey Blue 650kg in hot pursuit at 415p/kg for 650kg. Harvey Parkes' only star today sold to 408p/kg for 594kg, with heavies from Evans Curdale to £2949.20 for 730kg.

#### 24 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 392P/KG

Harvey Parkes usual quality sailed to 442p/kg for 490kg Limmie, with other Lims from Neale Dalton and Clare Burgoyne following on at 440p/kg and 438p/kg. A tremendous heavy Limousin, again from the Dalton stable, adding up to £2896.20 for 698kg.

#### 20 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 355P/KG

Tremendous meat on young Limousin bulls sold to 404p/kg for 708kg from Ben Rochelle, with his heaviest to £3017.60 for 820kg. Rob Pugh's run also were very fit, selling to 398p/kg on two occasions, and a third to 396p/kg. Hereford bulls sold to 388p/kg for 720kg from Edward Howells.
