93 PRIME CATTLE

A few more cattle were encouraged to market today, with a very wet morning and harvesting nearing its conclusion. Trade held firm throughout with buyers still leaving short of numbers in some cases. The whole yard of cattle were a credit to their producers with only a sprinkling of leaner sorts penned today.

Steers sold to a very respectable 290p/kg with no superstars forward. Heavy commercial bullocks sold to £1848 in the lump.

Butchers’ heifers were a buoyant trade once again with 16 cattle 300p/kg or above. 336p/kg was top price here with heavy females to £1865.

More bulls forward saw trade no faster, with the best to 284p/kg, and heavy continentals stacking up well to £2146. Plainer bulls saw trade a little steadier.

18 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 261P/KG

Blonde crosses from Rhys & Steve Perkins topped here at 290p/kg for 598kg, closely followed by Mrs B’s British Blue at 288p/kg for 562kg. Limmies from distance traveller Mr Willan sold to 282p/kg for 632kg. Phil Edwards 700kg Blue added up to £1848 at 264p/kg

46 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 287P/KG

A shapely little black Blue heifer stood out amongst strong competition at 336p/kg for 494kg, with Evans Curdale selling their best two red Limmies to 330p/kg for 536kg and 528kg respectively. Homebred Lims from Roger Jordin also topped at 330p/kg for 502kg. 508kg Blonde/Lims from Mrs B sold early on to 328p/kg, with heavier 574kg red Lims to 325p/kg from Andrew Meredith (£1865.50).

29 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 247P/KG

Two cracking Limousin bulls from the Powell family shone here at 284p/kg for 658kg with their heavy 764kg bull to 281p/kg (£2146.84). David Preece sold a shapely red Limousin to 278p/kg, with Colin & Howard Fish selling their run to 272p/kg for 584kg.

Friesians sold to 215p/kg from Charlie Lloyd for 550kg.
