It was good to see a client demand close to the festive break and I am sure that cattle will be required next Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> December. Please notify Mark Burgoyne of your potential entries and numbers for next Monday. Good buying support is anticipated, but we will need to notify them of our potential entry. See below some stunning prices once again with a headline price of 372p/kg.

Some very tidy steers penned today saw a rip-roaring trade to 350p/kg and a top price per head of £2190.

Heifers soared to 372p/kg or £2040 in the lump with 16 heifers 300p/kg or more.

Low bull numbers again saw good demand to a top of 288p/kg, with some very lean sorts selling to expectations.

7 cows saw a super trade with young meated sorts selling to 260p/kg for 668kg (£1787) with others to 235p/kg for 746kg (£1753).

#### 14 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 266P/KG

A cracking red Limmie from Mrs B excelled here at 350p/kg for 600kg (£2100), with Will Rodenhurst close behind at 345p/kg for 590kg (£2035.50). Mrs B also sold her Simmental cross to 310p/kg for 598kg and her Limousin cross to 305p/kg. Top price in the lump also went to that `deserving cause' at £2190 for 750kg shapey Limousin.

A very good entry of lambs and trade firmer, possibly a reflection of quality. Best Texel lambs over 300p/kg to 316p/kg for 46kg from Richard Morgan and heavier sorts to just over £140 to £163.80 from Stuart Moss. Clean, dry lambs 42kg to 46kg easily sold with the entire market averaging 265p/kg with the better end of the Commercials 270p/kg. Lambs under 40kg sold to 269p/kg for 38kg from Doug Heighway, with very little price fluctuation for lighter sheep.

Tomorrow (13<sup>th</sup> December 2023) is the start of VAN numbers in relation to the export of animal products. Today 189 pens of lambs were penned with only a handful without the new paperwork. However as of today, there seems to be confusion within the meat sector as to who requires this information. The advice would be if you are not Farm Assured then obtain a VAN number from your vet, as in the near future the paperwork is sure to change.
