55 PRIME CATTLE/3 CULL COWS

Auctioneer – Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603

A smaller entry of cattle met a similar trade with more second-string types amongst them. Demand is not particularly strong with the recent hot spell not helping sales of roasting joints, etc.

Fewer bullocks penned sold to a high of 390p/kg and £2,605 in the lump.

Heifers saw handy weights at 465p/kg with heavier females to £2,763.

Bull numbers not suffering quite as much as the clean, saw a high of 392p/kg or £2,869 in the lump.

3 barrens forward saw a top of 262p/kg for 614kg Limousin cross cow, with Devon crosses to 222p/kg for 732kg.

37 CLEAN CATTLE

13 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 325P/KG

Best quality types from Clive Evans topped here at 390p/kg for 668kg black, shapey Charolais steer with his red Limmie to 388p/kg for 670kg. John Cantrill's handier Simmentals sold to 375p/kg for 548kg. "Storified" steers helped to reduce the average here dramatically.

24 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 382P/KG

Rob Pugh's second trip was worth it as his 534kg Limousin headlined at 465p/kg with his 486kg Limousin also selling to 440p/kg. 614kg Limousins from Evans, Curdale stacked up nicely at 450p/kg or £2763 in the lump. 552kg Limousins sold in third spot for Mrs B, selling to 440p/kg with heavier heifers to 432p/kg and 420p/kg from the same home.

18 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 350P/KG

Shapey, tucked up Blues from Apley Farms headed here at 392p/kg for 732kg with Rob Pugh "mentioned in despatches" again at 390p/kg for 644kg. 680kg Lims from Will Rodenhurst sold to 382p/kg for 680kg.

A larger entry of lambs and trade exactly the same as last week with heavy lambs easily sold, selling to £189.50 for 52.5kg Texels at 361p/kg from Burwarton Farms.

This week's sale incorporated the Burwarton Show Live Dead Competition judged this year by Will Hough with results of the overall competition to be displayed at the Show on Thursday 7th August.

First prize was awarded to Andrew Preece whose 45.5kg Texels realised 424p/kg and £193 and were purchased by Bridgnorth High Street butcher Rob Arbuckle. Second prize to Ed Bunning for 42.5kg Texels sold to Saj Shan of Yorkshire Halal Meat.

Trade throughout the sale was very buoyant across all weights, notably Rob Jones' 48kg lambs at 371p/kg with lighter lambs at 41.5kg from George Evans to 380p/kg.
