With a good haymaking week forecast there were fewer beasts forward this morning. The larger supermarket suppliers took significant money out of their quotations for this week, so it was pleasing to see prices firming a little in some cases – a small 'glimmer' of light perhaps?

A dozen steers sold pretty well to highs of 390p/kg with other weights to £2842 in the lump.

Trade was sharp on butcher's cattle to 480p/kg! Heavier heifers sold to £2600.

Bull prices held their own with heavies excelling at 383p/kg or £2918.

Mrs B had top call here with her grey blue steer 648kg at 390p/kg, closely followed by John Cantrill who sold to 385p/kg for 568kg Limmie cross. British Blues from Evans Curdale did not stack up too badly with 812kg steers selling to £2842 and £2809. Red Herefords sold to 358p/kg for 514kg from Roger Rowson.
