Numbers tight once again, alongside quite a few cattle lacking meat and finish — consequently well-fleshed, properly fit cattle were dear to a high of 469p/kg and £3255 in the lump. Very low numbers of handyweight heifers — a trend looking set to continue as producers grow their cattle into money.

A small show of steers saw natives topping at 378p/kg and heavies to £2861.

Some `proper' heifers forward in a place or two saw a high of 469p/kg or £2776 as a whole.

Bull quality a little mixed but a first trade although to 439p/kg with heavies to £3255.

One Hereford cross cull cow sold nicely to 220p/kg for 712kg.

6 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 360P/KG

No best sucklers penned this morning saw Roger Rowson stealing the honours for his red Hereford cross at 378p/kg for 630kg and his dumpier Hereford to 363p/kg for 570kg. 792kg from Robert Watkins sold to £2851.20.

38 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 388P/KG

Four stars of Lims from Evans Curdale sold to a market high of 469p/kg for 592kg with others to 468p/kg, 458p/kg and 432p/kg, only to be split by Mrs B's two black Limmies selling to 442p/kg and 438p/kg for 568kg and 520kg respectively. Handyweight Lims from Dave Jones sold to 428p/kg, with Angus crosses to 422p/kg for 500kg.

20 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 371P/KG

Two shapey Lims from Ben Rochelle were headlining at 439p/kg for 628kg and 428p/kg for 648kg. Herefords from Georgia Delves also excelled with her 822kg selling to 396p/kg or £3255.12. 734kg Limousin bulls from Richard Price fell just short of £3,000 at 398p/kg.
