Cattle numbers remain tight but with larger abattoirs putting prices back this week the market remained constant, with some good quality cattle helping trade. There were fewer handy-weight butcher's types penned this morning and these sold to a marked premium.

A decent show of steers saw a top of 404p/kg with heavy bullocks to £2758.

Heifers excelled to 470p/kg with 12 selling over and above the 400p/kg mark, with heavy females to £2706.

Some good bulls forward saw a top of 415p/kg with heavies to £2895 in the lump.

John Cantrill's run topped this department at 404p/kg for 574kg Limousins, with Mrs B in second spot at 390p/kg for 682kg. A run of three from Evans Curdale saw two at 382p/kg for 722kg and 716kg, with others at 380p/kg for 720kg (Lims & Charolais). Traveller Ian Willan sold to 382p/kg for 716kg Limmie cross.

Harvey Parkes run of butchers' types sailed to a market topping 470p/kg for 528kg British Blues with other handyish heifers to 465p/kg and 438p/kg for 526kg Limousin crosses sold to 437p/kg from Simon Jones. Heavy heifers sold to £2706 for 660kg from Mrs B.

A very tidy and quiet red Limousin from the Kirton family was top price here at 415p/kg or £2714.10. Blondes from Hayden Burton took second at 395p/kg for 584kg, with Bill Rodenhurst selling to 388p/kg for 646kg. Heavies from Ben Rochelle added up nicely at £2895.20 for 752kg.

Every day last week the lamb trade slipped – a combination of reduced capacity, very slow export and the fact that lambs have been well in front of last year's values for a number of months. An average of 323p/kg which, by the end of this, will probably look very respectable.

Pete Morris' Beltex lambs took top honours at 396p/kg or £192 with the best lambs a very similar trade to last week. Customers were happy to bid at quality, but reluctant to get involved in plain, under-finished lambs.

Top price per head of £205 for George Evans 57kg Texels, heavier weights to 360p/kg and lambs under 40kg to 329p/kg for 34kg Blue Texels from Connor Badger.

With the ewe trade easing numbers remain strong, trade requiring meated ewes and, as you would expect, plenty of plainer ewes penned.

Heavy ewes to £235 from Ben Johnson and cross-bred ewes to just shy of £200. Roger Burgoyne's first pen was at £198, with Cheviot Mules £186 and Suffolk Mules £178.

Plainer ewes sold to £142 for Suffolk, £120 for North Country Mules, although more plainer sorts traded from between £80 to £100 than in recent weeks.

Hill ewes remain dear, with meated, medium Cheviots at £149, meated Improved Welsh £100. Although small plain ewes would prove challenging at times, they were still trading at £50 plus for lean Welsh types.

A typical Bridgnorth entry of cattle comprising of bulls, Aberdeen Angus, over-agers or all three combined.

Simmental heifers at 500kg topped the sale at £1840 from Gordon Young with 23-month Blues from Alan Forsyth at £1580 (400p/kg) and 375kg Blues from Michael Pratt at £1500 (421p/kg).

A run of Aberdeen Angus from George Breakwell to £1570 for 26-month heifers at 490kg. Steers to £1400 for Blues from Alan Forsyth and 390kg 'Native type' at £1400 (350p/kg). British White cows and calves sold to £1800.

Good entry of cattle required for our next Store Sale on Friday 29th August 2025, with entries invited for the catalogue by 12 noon on Tuesday 26th August.

1350 Store Sheep

Almost 700 store lambs which were generally smaller lean types, a reflection of the grass situation locally or more accurately, the lack of it.

Strong lambs that would feed inside, sold to £133 for tup lambs from Andrew Penny, £127 from Adrian Dale and £125 from Philip Brown.

Plenty of lambs over £100 although small long-term lambs traded at £75 to £90 with the lack of grass developing into a major concern.

650 breeding ewes topped at £248 for two pens of Texel yearlings form Glynn Morris with Texel cross yearlings to £228 and Suffolks to £234 from Simon Jones. Generally, trade would have been better than anticipated with several local auctions reporting breeding ewes being a very slow trade. Bridgnorth attracted plenty of potential customers who were prepared to buy breeding stock.


