Numbers very tight once again, coupled with strong demand, especially on clean cattle resulted in a very strong trade once again. There were fewer best butchers' handy weight cattle penned this morning and these met strong competition from start to finish. Cattle that were shapeless with no meat met the cow trade.

Only a sprinkling of steers saw a top call of 304p/kg and another to 302p/kg. There were no absolute top notchers forward. Top price per head of £1976.

13 heifers sold to 300p/kg or above to a high of 338p/kg on two occasions with heavier females to £1897 in the lump.

Only 3 cows forward saw Simmental crosses with some meat to 162p/kg for 732kg (£1185.84) with Herefords (non-assured) to 132p/kg (£955.68) for 724kg.

Bull trade was very similar to recent weeks with many bulls on the leaner side of ideal! Best Limmies sold to a high of 278p/kg with heavies to £1977 in the lump. Black and White trade was steady with a high of 208p/kg with a little shape.

51 CLEAN CATTLE

12 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 230P/KG

Probably a firmer trade than last week but with some 'also rans' penned to deplete averages. Red Limousins from 'Mrs B' at 650kg topped here at 304p/kg with leaner but shapier Lims from Andrew Carter to 302p/kg at 636kg. Over age Limousins from Dave Bradley sold to 265p/kg for 670kg. Red Herefords sold to 264p/kg from Phil Edwards.

39 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 285P/KG

338p/kg was top dollar today from Phil Edwards with his 550kg Blue Lim cross and Harvey Parkes with his 518kg British Blue. Red Limmies at 494kg from 'Mrs B' took third spot at 331p/kg. Heavy 580kg Limmies from Rob and Pete Hartley sold to 327p/kg to add up well at £1896.60. Tim Madeley is also well worth a mention as he empties his shed with a black 530kg model making 324p/kg. Any heifers with meat and finish in strong demand.
