84 PRIME CATTLE

Decent numbers of clean cattle forward but with bulls in shorter supply. With large abattoirs cutting kill and reducing quotations recently, trade held up pretty well although not at the heady heights seen in previous months. Plenty of competition for cattle as long as they were well-finished.

Small numbers of steers saw best shapes selling to 430p/kg with heavies to £2802 in the lump.

Butchers' heifers sold to 452p/kg with two others at 450p/kg. Heavy females added up to a high of £2945.

Very few suckler bulls penned today with mainly heavy dairy-breds forward. Best handy-weight sucklers sold to 410p/kg with heavier Angus crosses just short of £3000.

Two cows forward which were aged and plain, selling to 178p/kg for 702kg (£1250).

Two Bazadaises steers raced in the ring for Gaz Davies selling at 430p/kg for 598kg with 548kg to 418p/kg. Red Lims from Evans Curdale sold to 418p/kg and 416p/kg for 636kg and 652kg, with Black Lims to £2801.60 for 680kg at 412p/kg from Mrs B.

57 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 390P/KG

Charolais crosses from Harvey Parkes headed the day at 452p/kg for 548kg, with his 538kg Limousin to 450p/kg. 588kg Limousins from Evans Curdale also achieved 450p/kg, with Roger Jordin and Rhys Perkins both achieving 440p/kg. Heavy 722kg Limousins stacked up well for Dave Bradley at £2945.78.

Best sucklers sold to 410p/kg for tremendous Limousins from Bill Yeomans, with 664kg Limmies to 394p/kg from Stuart Bebb. Angus crosses from Stewart Cadwallader sold to £2971.96 for 778kg (382p/kg) with Herefords to 374p/kg for 654kg from Richard Yates.

SFI Announcement

On the 11th March 2025 the Rural Payments Agency announced that the Sustainable Farming Incentive scheme was closed for new applications with immediate effect. Those with existing SFI schemes will not be affected, and those with applications already submitted should still be offered an agreement, however going forward no new applications can be submitted. A reformed SFI scheme is set to be announced in the summer, but at this stage we are unsure of the exact timing or form of the scheme, but will keep you informed.
