A sprinkling more than last week with some very useful sorts forward in a place or two. More commercial types saw trade no better with quality types holding their values. Many abattoirs are only killing short weeks which is not helping get cattle off the farm.

Small steer numbers saw a high of 412p/kg or £2629 in the lump.

A reasonable heifer entry topped at 436p/kg or £2796.

Some quality bulls penned this morning sold to 414p/kg or £3127.

Cows coming forward more quickly, as grass supplies dwindle, met a decent trade with Limousin cows to 275p/kg for 720kg (£1980) with others to 272p/kg.

7 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 325P/KG

Last in from Ben Rochelle topped here — at 412kg Limousin cross at 626kg. 692kg Charolais from Evans Curdale sold to 380p/kg or £2629.60 with their second to 368p/kg for 676kg.

48 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 371P/KG

Some tidy handy heifers from Harvey Parkes headed the day at 436p/kg for 508kg, with his 576kg Limmie to 432p/kg from the same home. A good run from Mrs B saw two red Limmies sell to 432p/kg, with two others to 430p/kg. Shapey British Blues stacked up reasonably well for Mrs B once again at £2796.30 for 682kg (410p/kg).
