A two tier trade this Tuesday with buyers looking for more value in their beef, as demand is not quite as it was! Fewer beasts passed 400p/kg than we have seen – although quite a few cattle forward which were lacking meat, not helping averages.

Our steer entry was mixed with a high of 395p/kg on two occasions or £2650 in the lump.

Best heifers sold to 442p/kg with heavier females just shy of £2600.

Bulls with meat in short supply, selling to a realistic trade and to a high of 408p/kg or £2968 in the lump.

Only one fit Hereford cross cow which sold well to 295p/kg for 840kg (£2478).

58 CLEAN CATTLE

12 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 346P/KG

Young British Blue crosses from Mrs B sold to 395p/kg for 660kg with her second Limmie to the same for 642p/kg. 720kg dairy bred Lims sold to 368p/kg or £2649.60 from Samuel Jones. Roger Rowson's ultra fit red Herefords sold to 350p/kg for 606kg.

46 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 367P/KG

Bill Yeomans stole the limelight at Lot 1, selling to 442p/kg for 480kg and his second to 430p/kg for 484kg. Evans Curdale sold their super red Limmies to 438p/kg for 586kg, with their 614kg Lim to 420p/kg or £2578.80 in the lump. Harvey Parkes' beast realised 430p/kg for 506kg Limmie. 492kg Lims from Roger Jordin selling to 436p/kg.

11 BULLS SOLD TO OV AV 366P/KG

Definitely a fair trade if you had the goods!

A super-shapey British Blue from the Rodenhurst family headed at 408p/kg at 612kg, with a great run of cattle from David Jones selling to 400p/kg for 742kg or £2968, with others to 398p/kg or 380p/kg. Ultra lean types difficult to place whatever the price!
