With a short week in front of us, a smaller entry resulted with best cattle seeing a very tidy trade, but with a few also rans helping to pull averages back! Best butcher's cattle are sneaking up towards 500p/kg with a market high of 482p/kg.

A very mixed entry of steers from the best to the worst. Shapey Continentals sold to 438p/kg or £2709. With shapeless, small types depleting averages.

Some decent finished heifers forward sold to a topping 482p/kg with heavy females to £2793.

All bulls were well-finished today and also carried a bit of timber! Best sorts sold to 400p/kg or £3008 in the lump.

Take out the also-rans and the above average would hit 400p/kg. Max Ossig was top dog at 438p/kg and 430p/kg for 572kg and 630kg respectively – the heavier beast adding up to £2709. 618kg Blue crosses from Roger Rowson sold to 414p/kg.

Harvey Parkes had a good day selling his best to 482p/kg for 492kg with four others from 425p/kg to 465p/kg. 576kg Lims from Charlie Lloyd sold to 430p/kg, with Max Ossig mentioned in despatches again selling to 424p/kg for 514kg. 678kg Charolais crosses from Mrs B added up pretty well at £2793.56 with Dave Preece selling his 30m plus Blue to £2603.54 for 698kg.

## SFI Announcement

On the 11<sup>th</sup> March 2025 the Rural Payments Agency announced that the Sustainable Farming Incentive scheme was closed for new applications with immediate effect. Those with existing SFI schemes will not be affected, and those with applications already submitted should still be offered an agreement, however going forward no new applications can be submitted. A reformed SFI scheme is set to be announced in the summer, but at this stage we are unsure of the exact timing or form of the scheme, but will keep you informed.
