Struggling for numbers today with an anticipated upturn in trade perhaps holding cattle back, although a shortage of heads generally. A firmer trade with averages held back by a more ordinary show. Cattle with meat were sold to advantage and better entries will be required next Tuesday.

Reasonable steer numbers however saw a high of 416p/kg with £2715 in the lump for heavies.

Few handier weight heifers forward met a premium to 468p/kg with heavy females just short of £2700.

Quality not quantity in the bull department with best shapes past 400p/kg to 404p/kg and heavies to £2939.
