84 PRIME CATTLE

A few more cattle forward met a steady trade, with fridges getting stacked up as sales slowdown. The higher interest rates are beginning to have the desired effect perhaps? Trade probably back 10p/kg from recent sales. Steer numbers were pretty good with some tidy cattle forward selling to 317p/kg with heavies just short of £2000.

Harder work on butchers' cattle which topped at 338p/kg with 13 heifers at 300p/kg or more. Heavy females sold to £1853.

Reasonable bull numbers saw best Continentals at 266p/kg and just short of £1800 in the lump.

Two fit non-assured Limmie cows sold to 186p/kg for 866kg or £1610.76.

67 CLEAN CATTLE

17 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 263P/KG

Bazadaise steers from Jordin Bros topped here at 317p/kg for 572kg with a great run of Simmentals and Limousins from John Cantrill seeing his best to 280p/kg for 582kg. 636kg Limmies from Robert Watkins sold to 275p/kg. Heavy Charolais from Mike Evans stacked up at £1945.30 for 794kg.

50 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 270P/KG

Heavyweight Limmies from Harvey Parkes & Co stole the limelight here at 338p/kg with other half tonnes to 326p/kg. 530kg red Limousins from Evans, Curdale excelled at 332p/kg with Roger Jordin's 508kg model at 328p/kg. Andrew Meredith sold his best to 319p/kg at 548kg with 538kg Hereford x Limousins to 312p/kg from 'Mrs B'. Heavy Lims at 590kg added up for Curdale Farms again at £1852.60. A few 'also-ran's would have taken the edge off the averages.

18 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 240P/KG

Several tidy handy Continentals forward sold to 266p/kg for 668kg from Richard Povall with two from Robert Hartley selling to 265p/kg. Tim Madeley's useful Simmental crosses topped at 264p/kg. Bulls that were too lean were harder to place today.

STORE SALE REPORT – FRIDAY 30th JUNE 2023**95 STORE CATTLE**

A reasonable show of mainly cattle needing to graze this summer met a fair trade for the goods especially as most derived from the milking herd. All steers averaged 220p/kg, heifers 211p/kg and bulls 180p/kg.

Steers topped at £1300 for Jamie Griffin at 14 months with quick Blondes from Mr England at £1080 for 17 months. Hereford cross steers from Sam Jordan sold to £1030 at 16 months.

Some tidy heifers today sold to £1380 for Charolais heifers from Mr England with Angus heifers to £1290 from the same home. Jamie Griffin's 14-month Limmies topped at £1240 with Steve Crump selling his Simmental crosses to £1100 at 16 months. Hereford cross heifers to £1070 for Mr Clarke.

Graham Williams topped the bulls at £850 for 10.5 month Blues.
