112 PRIME CATTLE

A much busier cattle section following last week's Bank Holiday lull saw trade holding up well but perhaps not quite the 'zip' of last Tuesday. There were some tremendous well finished cattle penned this morning and the yard of cattle were a real credit to our regular suppliers. It must be noted that the large supermarket abattoirs pulled money out of the job once again this week!

Good steer numbers saw a high of 328p/kg with heavy steers to £2025 in the lump.

The 'heady heights' of 361p/kg were reached today with heavier females selling to £1944. 12 heifers sold to 300p/kg or above.

More of a mixed bag of bulls saw best sucklers selling to 298p/kg and heavy continentals to £2068. Black and Whites topped at 230p/kg.

5 cull cows forward saw a sharp trade with young fed Blues selling to 227p/kg and a top price per head of £1534.52. Plain, non assured were a fair rap at 137p/kg.

22 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 271P/KG

Bazadise steers from Roger Jordin headed this section at 328p/kg for 560kg with a great run of Lim x Sims from John Cantrill selling to 300p/kg for 538kg. A superb 719kg Limmie at 31m added up nicely for the Preece family.

61 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 281P/KG

Roger Jordin had all the aces today selling his best Limmie heifer at 494kg to 361p/kg with Rhys Perkins in second spot with a 510kg Limmie at 359p/kg. A great run from Evans (Curdale) sold to 356p/kg for 546kg with others to 347p/kg, 328p/kg and 320p/kg. 488kg Lims from Dan Watkins sold to 322p/kg with 'Mrs B's' best heifer to 320p/kg for 540kg. Heifers added up to £1943.76 for 546kg from the Curdale stable with Dave Preece's Charolais to £1938.80 for 740kg.

Homebred Limousins from Bill Yeomans excelled at 298p/kg and 290p/kg for 496kg and 584kg respectively with a heavy weight 718kg Limmie from Richard Yates to £2067.84 (288p/kg). Rob Hartley sold his best to 281p/kg with Dan Watkins' sharp Limmie to 282p/kg for 616kg. 642kg Holsteins sold to 230p/kg from Charlie Cadwallader

Trade a little easier averaging 320p/kg although as recent weeks, meated finished lambs much easier to sell than the plainer under finished sheep.

Harvey Parkes Texel lambs topped the sale at 348p/kg for 40kg and £160.75 for 47kg lambs from Rita Corfield.

Generally, very much a two tier price with finished lambs 320p/kg to 340p/kg and lambs requiring more time around 300p/kg. Heavier lambs to 342p/kg for 47kg and mainly around 320p/kg for lambs over 44kg with shape. Lambs under 40kg to 337p/kg for 39kg Texels from Fraser Hudson.

Clipped sheep with meat take no selling whatsoever and heavy hogs add up to a top price of £153.30 for Texels from Chris Jones.

Hogs under 40kg to 271p/kg for 36.5kg from Rob Rose. Meated hogs 40kg to 44kg from 260p/kg to 290p/kg and hogs over 45kg generally 250p/kg to 275p/kg.

The trade is requiring large, lean ewes with over fat ewes experiencing price resistance with the leaner ewes much dearer per kilo than heavier, fatter sorts.

Smaller ewes showing signs of improvement with Cheviot types to just shy of £100, Scotch Black Face to £90, Welsh £67 and Beulah £95.

FARMING EQUIPMENT & TECHNOLOGY FUND GRANTS IN 2023

Grants for farmers, horticulturalists, forestry owners and contractors for specific items of equipment.

ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE *CLOSES NEXT THURSDAY 15th JUNE AT MIDDAY*

The **Animal Health and Welfare** theme, which is now open, includes items such as:- mobile or fixed cattle handling systems, cattle crushes, head scoops, mobile or fixed sheep handling systems, weigh bars, electric fencing and ventilation fans.



The grants are for a minimum of £1,000 and maximum of £25,000 per theme, and are based on set grant amounts for each item. The grant element is usually around 40% of the item's cost, however if the price of the item you purchase results in the grant payment making up a lesser or greater percentage, this will not affect the amount of grant paid, so long as the requirements below are still met.

These requirements include all equipment which is purchased to meet the minimum specifications set out within the option guidance, to be brand new (ex-demo or second hand is not allowed) and purchased through a supplier or manufacturer. All items must also be paid for in full (part exchange is not allowed) and no items must be purchased before a grant funding agreement is offered, although it is possible to secure items with a refundable deposit if you are concerned about supply issues.

The application process is competitive with each item given a score, and applications with the highest average scores then being offered agreements.
