71 PRIME CATTLE/1 CULL COW

Struggling for numbers once again with the bull entry back on recent weeks. A sharp trade from start to finish with some very, very lean types hindering averages. 15 cattle sold on or above that magic 300p/kg figure, but with more commercial wholesaling cattle very dear.

There were some useful steers penned this morning, which saw 2 Continentals selling to 316p/kg with heavy steers to £1903 in the lump.

Butcher’s heifers were a very good trade and topped at 346p/kg with heavier females to £1833. Quality and not quantity in the bull section saw best Continentals selling to 290p/kg or just short of £2000 in the lump. Black & Whites a mixed trade selling passed 200p/kg if they had meat.

One Dexter OTM cow sold to 90p/kg for 426kg.

58 CLEAN CATTLE

21 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 279P/KG

Real shape from Mrs B saw her two Continentals sell to 316p/kg for 558kg and 562kg respectively, with better finished Limousins all in the 290p/kg from the same stable. 606kg Saler steers sold to 294p/kg from Phil Edwards. 624kg Charolais from Mike Evans topped at 282p/kg. Andrew Carter’s useful Limousin sold to £1902.78 for 682kg.

37 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 282P/KG

Handyweight Limousins from Harvey Parkes & Co excelled at 346p/kg, 345p/kg, 344p/kg and 340p/kg all around that 500kg weight. Quick Limmies from Dan Watkins sold to 340p/kg with John Hewitts model to 331p/kg. Glyn Powell will hopefully ‘perk up’ with his Blonde heifer adding up nicely to £1832.64 for 664kg.

A very similar entry of lambs to last week and trade averaging 254p/kg, several consignments of well-finished quality lambs which sold well, topping at 287p/kg for 41.5kg Beltex lambs from Caroline Evans on two occasions and Harvey Parkes 44kg.

Heavy lambs sold to £153.30 for 70kg Texels from Philip Corfield but generally lambs over 50kg £130, plus notably Ed Bunning 54kg shapey Texels at £142.50.

Any sort of meated lamb weighing under 40kg attracted spirited bidding with indoor 38.5kg lambs to 272p/kg from Pete Kirton. More lambs could easily be sold every week.
