### 63 PRIME CATTLE

With the larger players taking money out of the job as they have been threatening for weeks, the live ring continues to offer an obvious safe-haven! An absolutely ‘blistering, off the clock trade’ can be reported today, with 16 cattle exceeding 300p/kg, to a record high of 360p/kg!

There were some decent steers forward, without any real superstars, and sold to an exceptional 348p/kg or £2081 in the lump.

Heifers were “on fire” selling to 360p/kg with heavier females to £2023 in the lump. 4 cattle sold to 350p/kg and above.

Some very decent stuff shown in the bull section saw best sucklers to 288p/kg but without many best heavies in top price per head of £1976 was recorded. Black & White bulls in strong demand selling to 245p/kg or £1622. Only 3 cull cows forward found trade moving forward with 592kg sharp Angus selling to 179p/kg and 604kg “granny” Limmies to 166p/kg. Cows in strong demand each week.

#### 11 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 287P/KG

Mrs B sold her Limmie above expectation today to 348p/kg for 598kg or £2081.04 in the lump. 610kg Charolais crosses from Rob Watkins took second spot at 308p/kg for 610kg with John Cantrill selling his good run to 298p/kg for 616kg.

#### 28 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 302P/KG

A great run from Evans Curdale sailed to 360p/kg for 522kg with three heavier females to 352p/kg and 350p/kg (x 2), the largest adding up well at £2023. Handy 510kg Limmies from Mrs B hit 346p/kg with Harvey Parkes 544kg Limmie to 338p/kg. Jamie Griffin sold his well topped half-ton Lim to 322p/kg. A few small, under-finished types would help to reduce the overall average also.

#### 24 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 250P/KG

Two home-bred, shapey Limmies from Stuart Bebb excelled at 288p/kg and 286p/kg around 630kg mark, with Charolais to 278p/kg again from that ‘deserving cause’ at 648kg. 754kg Limmies from Dave Preece lumped up well at £1975.48 with his Black & Whites selling to an outstanding 245p/kg for 662kg (£1621.90)

A strange trade starting off around 340p/kg to 350p/kg then quickly back to 315p/kg to 320p/kg, averaging 330p/kg. The only consistency being that well-finished lambs up to 42kg were keenly contested.

The top price of 368p/kg went to Harvey Parkes' 40kg Texel lambs and a top price per head of £161 for 46kg Texels from P&J Corfield - both pens sold during the few minutes when the general trade was sticky, proving that meat and shape pays. Light lambs 32.5kg from Dave Roberts sold to 348p/kg, with lambs weighing over 48kg harder work.

## FARMING EQUIPMENT & TECHNOLOGY FUND GRANTS IN 2023

Grants for farmers, horticulturalists, forestry owners and contractors for specific items of equipment.

### ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE – \* NOW OPEN UNTIL MIDDAY ON THURSDAY 15<sup>th</sup> JUNE\*

The **Animal Health and Welfare** theme, which is now open, includes items such as:- mobile or fixed cattle handling systems, cattle crushes, head scoops, mobile or fixed sheep handling systems, weigh bars, electric fencing and ventilation fans.



The grants are for a minimum of £1,000 and maximum of £25,000 per theme, and are based on set grant amounts for each item. The grant element is usually around 40% of the item's cost, however if the price of the item you purchase results in the grant payment making up a lesser or greater percentage, this will not affect the amount of grant paid, so long as the requirements below are still met.

These requirements include all equipment which is purchased to meet the minimum specifications set out within the option guidance, to be brand new (ex-demo or second hand is not allowed) and purchased through a supplier or manufacturer. All items must also be paid for in full (part exchange is not allowed) and no items must be purchased before a grant funding agreement is offered, although it is possible to secure items with a refundable deposit if you are concerned about supply issues.

The application process is competitive with each item given a score, and applications with the highest average scores then being offered agreements.

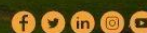
