

# CARMARTHEN LIVESTOCK MART WEEKLY REPORT – 06.06.25



## 81 BARREN COWS

Excellent numbers keep coming forward to Carmarthen on a weekly basis with all grades of barrens competed for by 13 dealers on the ringside. Higher numbers of beef cows forward this week than dairy reaching tops of £2790 for 64-month-old tested limmie cow weighing 800kg at 349ppk from Calogale transport Ger Y Coed who also obtained £2780 for 141-month-old limmie cow weighing 850kgs at 327p/kg. Others to £2490 for 116-month-old non tested limmie cow from Jones Brynmeini.

Bulls peaked at £2710 for 62-month-old Hereford weighing 1020kg at 266ppk from Thomas White Hall followed by 136-month-old Charolais also 1020kg at 255ppk to lump of £2600 from Williams Bros Penllwyngwent with an 870kg Angus at 271p/kg from Pincombe Henllan farm to total of £2360.

Dairy barrens lesser in numbers this week, peaked at £2000 for 31-month-old Holstein cow weighing 600kgs at 333ppk.

P/KG peaked at 363ppk for 37-month-old non tested limmie heifer weighing 590kg to lump of £2140 from Thomas Ystlys Y Coed, others to 353ppk for 665kg Lim cow from Morgan & Sons Penrhys fawr with above mentioned lots to 349, 333 and 327ppk.

Numbers tighten for the first week of June and trade surprisingly goes up a notch and arguably to where we were when beef was at its peak this year!! No doubt the meat would be in line with national trends as deadweight quotations continue to plummet! Grazing and young stores would be very dear with A Jones topped the steers at £2280 with suckler bred 560kg Lim steer from G V Thomas Selling next at £2270. Further Anguses & limmie bullocks from both vendors sold to £2260 & £2220 respectively. Charolais steers sold to highs of £2200 from L Davies with 12-month-old Lim steer from messers Jones selling at £2180. Organic Sim x from A R Hall sold to £2020 with 20-month-old Limmies from J M M Harries sold to £2000. Beef shorthorn steer from Danyralt Farms also making it to £2000 with endless runs of bullocks £1900 and over!! 21-month-old BRBX at 350ppk sold dearest per kilo at £1680 or high of 480ppk from TMB, RI & A Jones with 20-month-old Hereford steer from J A & L R James selling next at 467.7ppk (310kg @£1450), 430kg limmie from DRW Jones looked tremendously sold at £1990 or 462.8ppk as all steers levelled out at a very respectable £1700.

A few less bulls this Friday with D D J & L M Evans picking the best of them at £1630 with others to £1600.

Heifers peaked at £2370 (408.6ppk) for 580kg Lim x heifer from A M & R W Davies. AA from A Jones again in the headlines selling next at £2230. Two wonderful pure limmies from D M Williams sold at £2150 & £2200 with

Plenty again of heifers up and around that £1900 with the grazing types well into that 400-450ppk bracket. 447.6ppk was top spot per kilo for a heifer of 420kg from D M Williams selling at £1880. 13-month-old Charolais heifer sold to follow at 441.2ppk (340kg @£1500).
