Dairy types to £1560 for 119-month-old non tested Holstein cow weighing 794kg at 197ppk from Thomas penlan home farm followed by £1490 for 113-month-old non tested Holstein weighing 792kg at 188ppk from Roberts Garn.

Bulls to max of £16820 for 57-month-old 872kg angus bull at 193ppk from Morgans Blaengorlech.

Top ppk was above mentioned limmie heifer at 277ppk followed at 263ppk for 621kg (41-month-old) limmie cow to a lump of £1630 from Jenkins Cathal.

Trade shifting through the gears nicely for what was a cracking show of cattle. Vendors rewarded for the quality with current prime values driving the store prices to new territories. Endless stores over £1900 and it was the heifer section which found the top prices this week. 570kg Lim x heifer from G Morgan topped at £2000 (350ppk) with dairy bred blues finding highs of £1960 from Mabws hen farm & W & H K Jenkins at £1950. 16-month-old limies from G L, J S & A Howells sold to £1930 for 570kg (378.4ppk). A pile of 500kg heifers over £1800 with the quality of heifers forward reflected in the average of £1460.07. The younger cattle have taken a massive leap with 10-month-old 320kg Charolais heifers flying to £1190 and 371.9ppk from L Davies. Mr Davies also topped the steers per kilo with 10month-old Charolais bullock weighing 300 kg selling to £1210 and 403.3ppk. 27-month-old Lim steers from DT & H W Griffiths topped the steers at £1920 (358.9ppk) with 30month-old dairy bred lims from O, S J & J E Davies selling next at £1860. D T & E M Thomas sold their bet steers to £1850 with plenty of strength around the 500kg £1750-£1800.

Previously mentioned the young cattle a "real" trade with endless runs 380-400ppk. Dairy bred BB steers from E D Davies & CO flew to £1590 at just 410kg (387.8ppk). 10-month-old lim X from P J Hawkins sold to £1470 & £1480 and many more can be handled at Carmarthen every Friday!!
