Dairy types to max of £1700 for 28-month-old non tested Holstein heifer weighing 663kgs at 256ppk from Cribor fach farm who also had 125-month-old Holstein cow weighing 753kgs at 203ppk to a lump of £1530.

Bulls to tops of £1700 for 22-month-old tested limmie weighing 642kgs at 265ppk from Sams Garn Goch which was top price p/kg with many lots being over 240ppk.

Fierce bidding for all types with plenty of the stronger end finding highs of over £2000. Top steer sold to £2100 for 680kg stabiliser from H Phillips who sold others to £2000 and £1950. Dairy bred blue steers sold to £2080 for 635kg from WT & D L Organ with dairy bred Limmie bullocks selling at £2020 for 600kg (336.7ppk) from H S Evans. Beef Shorthorn steer to £1900 for 590kg from P Devonald with endless 500kg cattle £1800-£1900. 9-month-old Lim steer from E Davies sold to £1240 or highs of 435.1ppk for 285kg. P J Hawkins sold his run of Lim cattle to £1410 for 11-month-old 360kg which returned at 391.7ppk on paper. Several runs 370-390ppk with all steers levelling out at £1599.49.

360kg 8-month-old bulls sold to £1100 or 306ppk from D E & D M Roberts with 315kg bull from E G & J Beynon & Son selling next at £1080 or 342.9ppk. 9-month-old bulls from D T Thomas & Co looked very well sold at £1010 or 360.7ppk or highs of 360.7p/kg.

34-month-old beef shorthorn heifer topped the section at £2270 for 750kg from K Thomas with a shapey 580kg BRBx selling next at £2100 or 362.1ppk from G L, J S & A Howells. 20-month-old Charolais from D E & D M Jones sold to £2010 with other Charolais from T E Jones LTD selling next at £1980. Dairy bred Angus to £1950 for 605kg from O & S J & J E Davies with several 600kg+ heifers over £1900. 490kg Lim x from GL, J S & A Howells sold to £1850 or 377.6ppk with a 450kg heifer from the same home flying to £1820 or 404ppk. 310kg-12-month-old limmie also flew to £1260 and high of 406.5ppk. All heifer came back at an overall average of £1315.88 with all store cattle levelling out at 330ppk.
