Incredible numbers for time of year with trade certainly pulling the cattle to the market. Prices on fire from start to finish with the young cattle arguably even dearer on the week. The big cattle a stand on trade and tremendously sold for all breeds forward. Top of the steers sold to £2310 from a very good home from our Gail and family. This was for a 620kg BRB with 610kg Blues from ED & AA Davies selling next at £2230. A fantastic run of Charolais cattle from JJ Howells peaked at £2200 for 520kg or 423.1p/kg. Charolais 15kg lighter from the same home to 2190 and 433p/kg with 440kg selling to £1990.00 or 452.3p/kg. Other 21month Charlie steers from DE & DM Jones sold to £2140. Dairy bred Charolais from E Thomas selling to £2100 with Limmie & Hereford steers also trading at £2100 from JD Jones & Co and Messrs Davies respectively. 12month old BRB's from N Davies to £1820 with a real trade seen for the youngers steers this week. 260kg from MDM Farms topped per kilo smashing the 500p/kg barrier at 503.8p/kg (£1310). All steers levelled out at £1590.49 or 364.14p/kg. Feeding bulls sold to highs of £1380.00 for AA from R Condell with a couple of 9month old Limousin selling to highs of 400p/kg for 275kg at £1100 from GK Duggins.

A storming 31month old Charolais heifer weighing 710kg topped the section this week at £2480 from DEW & E Evans with other Charolais to £2290 from RJB & AM Tucker. 21month Limmie from DE & DM Jones sold next at £2090 with TG Morgan selling his wonderful run to highs of £2030 for 480kg and 422.9p/kg. 21month Charolais from JJ Howells topped per klio with 395kg sailing to £1750 and 443p/kg. 390kg Charolais from CR & DM Griffiths next in line selling 390kg at 430p/kg and £1680.00 with plenty over 420p/kg here this Friday. All heifers levelled out at £1402.60 and 340p/kg. 24 cattle cross £2000 and 41 cattle break the 400p/kg barrier.
