Top of £1795 was for 27-month-old Angus bull weighing 845kg at 212.4ppk from Jones Ffosddu, next at £1670 twice for a pair of Hereford cows from Williams Penralltfangor and Twose Family Maenhir.

Top dairy type was £1540 for 83-month-old Holstein cow from CGMT LTD Madox Farm followed by £1490 for 50-month-old cow at 690kg at 215.9ppk from Beynon Glantowy.

Top ppk was 231ppk for 105-month-old limmie cow weighing 710kg from Jones Great Lunnon to a total of £1640 followed by 228.3ppk for 600kg Lim cow from Mainwaring to total of £1370.
