Another week of excellent numbers through the barren ring, with a flyer of a trade on all grades of barrens.

Top price of £2590 for 122m old non tested limmie cow weighing 817kgs at 317ppk from Jones Long Oaks who also had a 655kg at 327ppk to a lump of £2140!!

Jones Blaencwmerwydd sold a tested limmie cow, 101-month-old weighing 709kgs at 317ppk to total of £2250.

Top dairy barren at £2150 for 67-month-old tested Holstein cow weighing 837kgs at 257ppk from CGMT LTD followed at £2080 for 93-month-old Holstein cow weighing 826kg at 252ppk from Jones Hafod who also had £1950 for 778kg at 251ppk Holstein again.

OTM's peaked at £2290 for 66-month-old tested limmie steer weighing 755kgs at 303ppk from Mainwaring Penplas.

Top ppk was 327ppk for above mentioned limmie cow, with others as above to 317ppk and 303ppk.

58 cattle sell over £2000 for what was an outstanding trade for all types forward. Big or small, no matter at all with the small rough cattle meeting a trade never seen before!!

26-month-old dairy bred BRB steers at 680 and 665ppk flew to high of £2650 and £2480 respectively from T C & E G G Evans & Son. Suckler bred limmie steer weighing 605kg from D E & D M Jones selling at £2490. Herefords steers to £2450 from E W & C W Evans with a run of two-year-old lim steers from W M & M E G Evans also selling to highs of £2450. 18-month-old Charolais steer from E T Jenkins sold to £2420 for 535kg which was one of the highlights per kilo at 452.3ppk. Longhorn steer also crossing the 400ppk barrier at £2400 from T Organ with several runs of steers £2400 and over. Out wintered dairy bred blues from D L & M Jones found highs f £2160 (525kg) with 12-month sold limmie bullock from T M J & G A Evans selling to £2150 or 425.7ppk. 11-month-old Hereford steers peaked at 500ppk (240kg) at £1200 from J D & S C Edwards with other 11-month-old Lim steers from, P J Hawkins selling at £1420 for 330kg and 430.3ppk. Less bulls forward this week with a Hereford from E Davies & son selling to a top of £1460 with 10-month-old Lims from W I S Jones & Co selling next at £1400 and bang on 400ppk. 10-month Lims weighing 265kg from S J Honebun topped per kilo at 411.3ppk selling at £1090 per head!!

640kg Angus heifers from Davies bros topped the heifer section at £2480 with 580 kg Lim from B W Evans close behind at £2420 and 417.2ppk. Another Angus again from the Davies brothers sold at £2350 with lims from W M & M E G Evans selling at £2290. 565kg Charolais from B W Evans over the 400ppk barrier at £2270 with dairy bred blues from E W & C W Evans selling to £2210. 330kg Lim x heifer from D P & J Griffiths flew to £1480 and high of 448.5ppk with 450kg pure Lim heifer from P Davies selling next at £1930 and 428.9ppk. G Poulton sold two heifers at 423ppk with runs and runs of heifers over the 400ppk barrier.
