A memorable day in the capital with dairy cattle trading hands at very hot prices with juicy headlines seen throughout!! This week included the Holstein south Wales show and sale which always attracts those extra special individuals. This was certainly the case this week with Judges Robin & Mari Thomas, Dolau blessed with quality in the show ring. Full show results are listed below with highlights from the days show seeing the overall champion, Deri Barb 7 from the Deri herd selling at £4000 to the judge's home at Dolau. Reserve champion was awarded to T L & D A R Thomas for Dulais Unix Ashlyn which sold at £3100 to the Davies family Penybanc Uchaf. Trade was on fire from start to finish in the fresh department with DR Evans selling two heifers at £3700 and R Hammett selling to £3450. 10 heifers over £3000 with all heifers levelling out at £2639.72. A very consistent cow trade with Cribor fach CYF displaying a tremendous run of commercial cows to highs of £3100 and £3000. Plenty £2500 and over with all cows levelling out at £2526.32. A run of dry cows sold to £2100 from E J & E C Thomas with Friesian types from Vaynor farm LTD selling to £1950. Dairy youngstock a pleasure to sell and very positive to see great numbers of maiden to in-calf heifers forward. Many more could have been easily sold today such was the demand with a run of in calf heifers from Birdcombe farm LTD, the pick of the bunch selling to high of £2600 twice for August and September calvers with a Barberry heifer, one of the last from the Gatrog herd from Elwyn & Cheryl selling at £2400. Endless in-calf heifers over £2000 with all averaging £2112.27. Bulling heifers quite an extraordinary trade selling to high of £1680 from Cribor fach with others from D A Williams & Sons selling 6to £1650. All 20 bullers levelled out at £1506.84. A run of maiden heifers from M L Harries sold to £780 for two Flec heifers with an 8-monthold pure Jersey looking well sold at £700 again from M L harries. All maidens averaged out at £682.86.

One heifer calf from Parcyrabbott sold at £280.
