Another Wednesday and another heifer reaching £4000 making it 4 weeks on the bounce!! Trade very hot for all fresh with demand certainly outstripping supply!! The Deri herd from D R Evans headlined the fresh heifer this week for a K & L chance daughter making it to £4000 and Dante Holti selling to £3900. Others from the same home to £3850 with G Williams selling his Aladdin Lavender heifer to £3700. 14 heifers sold over £3000 with endless runs of £2500-£3000. All heifers levelled out at £2907.24 (£80 up on the week). Steventon Topmodel, a 4th calver from E Thomas topped the cows giving 48-50kg at £3400. Two 2nd calvers from P & E J Morris & Sons sold next at £2800 each with the best of 3 strong herd cows from G B & C A Davies selling at £2680. All cows levelled out at £2421.54. 6 in calf heifers from the FENNI herd topped at £2850 for a September calving heifer with others to £2800, November calvers to £2500 with a run of heifer calves from E & I Davies selling to £500. Mid lactation cows from E W Jenkins looked well sold at £1650 with several individuals £1500 and over.
