A very decent entry with close to 50 fresh and generally in line with previous weeks with trade feeling the resistance of where we were a couple of months ago. However, two heifers making it to £3000, one for a 35kg litre from J G T Griffiths and a rubicon heifer from A J & D P Boucher. Plenty trading £2700-£2850 with 17 in total over £2500 this week. Some other highlights saw a Friesian type heifer from R Hammett selling to £2700 with a couple of ¾ heifers selling at £1700. All heifers levelled out at a respectable £2158.84. D G & R P Lewis topped the 3 cows entered for a 3rd calver giving 37kg at £2850. 2nd calver from R D M S & R G Evans sold next at £1900. A wide selection of dairy youngstock this week with a month-old heifer calf kicking the day off at £380 from W S M Francis. In-calf heifers flew to £2000 for a very strong heifer a month away from calving from B Patten. Bulling heifers found highs of £1070 from A & S Griffiths with plenty of demand seen for all types of youngstock. Get in touch if you have any to sell. Record for a calf broken again this week to top of £815 for 1 month old Charolais bull from Lloyd & Co Pontmarchog. Simmies to £790 from Hughes Godregarreg who also had a limmie to £775, blues to £780 from Davies Fron with 6 other blues from £700 to £770 from various vendors, Angus to £568 from Morgan Pentrewyn, Herefords to £500 from Owen Pantygwiail and dairy bulls to £240 from Davies Glanrwyth.

Heifers to max of £685 for 1 month old Charolais again from Lloyd & Co Pontmarchog who had similar lots to £655, £650 and £570. Blues to £670 from HLJ27, Simmies to £625 from Jones Ty Llwyd Mawr, lims to £535 from Davies Blaenyresgair, Angus to £440 twice from Griffiths Llwyngwcw and Herefords to £385 from Davies Ty Canol.
