The store entries have been excellent all year round and once again it was good to see over 100 cattle filling the pens. Trade was also buoyant with steers selling to £1350 and heifers to £1020. Prizes were awarded for top price steers and heifers as well as a group of three cattle. Top prize steer was a super 19-month Limousin from Lloyd Thomas, Cefnmystrich who also took the Group of 3 with 14-month steers selling at £1180. Top price heifers were a pair of Simmental heifers from Severs, Gelli Isaf Farm at £1020. A good show of steers saw many cross the £1000 and return an average of £806, while heifers averaged £746 throughout.
