315 NEW SEASON LAMBS (324.13avg /kg)

Supply tight with the warm weather certainly affecting the well finished numbers. Meat essential and creeping the lambs meeting high premiums. E Davies topped the section selling 46kg to £159.50 or high of 347ppk. The heavy lambs continued to be in high demand but again, Flesh and finish essential. 50kg from M B Ellis sold to £166 with the overs weights from A H Davies also selling to £165. Lighter lambs a sharper trade on the week with 30kg lambs from G Hicks to 335ppk with 35,5kg from G Hicks selling to 330ppk. The general run either side of 330ppk with the plain types bringing the overall average back to 324.13ppk.
