### 197 NEW SEASON LAMBS (345.36avg /kg)

Double the amount of lambs this Thursday with the warm weather no doubt making these lambs finish better. Trade very steady throughout and not to last weeks highs but selling in line with national trends and towering deadweight quotations!! Several firms wanting those 40-44kgs lambs with well covered lambs essential!! 44kg lambs from J M Reed topped the section at 380ppk and £156 a head. 40kgs from the same home to £147 or 368ppk with 39kgs from D E Davies selling at £145 or 372ppk. Trade generally 350-360ppk with the heavy weight lambs at 300ppk with all lambs levelling out at 345.36.ppk.
