TO VENDORS AND PURCHASERS

Conditions of Sale

All stock are sold under the auspices of the Livestock Auctioneers Association Ltd Conditions of Sale (2009 edition).

Payment Terms

Strictly by Cash or Cheque on day of sale. Purchasers attending for the first time should make prior arrangement for payment.

Special Conditions Cattle

- All cattle must be accompanied by their relevant passports correctly signed and completed.
- A FULLY completed movement document (available from Nock Deighton Agricultural Auctioneers) must be handed in to the auctioneers on the arrival of cattle.
- All cattle must be double-tagged.
- All cattle found without passports, incorrect passports or missing eartags, will be withdrawn from sale.
- Purchasers have 2 working days in which to notify the auctioneers of incorrect passports or missing eartags.

Pregnancy Diagnoses

Female cattle sold as pregnancy diagnosed positive are warranted in calf for 30 days following the sale unless otherwise stated at the time of sale.

Bovine Tuberculosis Tests

All cattle which are 42 days of age or older are warranted tested negative for TB within 60 days prior to the sale or have moved from 3 or 4 year testing parishes. It is the responsibility of the vendor to provide the Auctioneers with valid test dates prior to sale (i.e. on movement forms or veterinary test sheet).

Sheep

- All ewes or ewe lambs that have lambed or are in lamb are sold as warranted correct on tooth and udder unless otherwise stated.
- All complaints regarding descriptions etc. of sheep must be lodged with the Auctioneers within one hour of the sale or before removed from the market whichever is sooner.
- Any sheep found incorrectly described being unsound in the udder, the Vendor shall pay 30% of the purchase price.
- Vendors must ensure all descriptions are correct.
