Another respectable number of calves today which met a brisk trade throughout.

Topping the sale today was a Lim bull calf which sold for £425, closely followed by another Lim bull calf at £385. Several other continental crosses also reaching the £370 mark. Hereford bulls were also forward today which sold for over £200 with Angus calves also to £245. Heifer calves topped at £360 for a strong Charolais calf.

The best blues to £272 closely followed by a Hereford heifer to £270 with several other to £248, £242 and £238.

More calves could easily have been sold today, with buyers noting that they are hoping to slowly increase their numbers from now onwards, so keep them coming.

Good outfits from one farm being all aged cows with mainly 2 month old BB calves at foot. Plenty of bidding seeing the best pair sell to £1110 with others at £1050.

One 4 year Herford breeding bull sold to £1150.

188 STORE CATTLE

An Excellent entry of well-bred suckler and dairy type cattle penned up this week with a packed ring full of buyers ensuring a roaring trade throughout. Those short term big cattle were in excellent demand and prices hit highs of £1305.

Charolais steers ended up at £1305 with a smart Limmie bullock selling next at £1160. Sim steers sold to £1135 with Herefords to £1100. Dairy bred Herefords sold to £1050 with younger Lim steers selling very well at £1015. Young 11 month old Sim steers sold to £1005 with dairy bred feeding Blues selling to £985. Yearling Charolais sold to £955 with Friesian steers selling to £890. Young beef shorthorn steers sold to £645 and a super trade seen on Angus cattle with 12 month old Angus steers selling to £945.

It was more of the same on the heifers with those large meaty heifers selling to highs of £1170. 14 month Charolais sold to £1155 with Simmental's to £1110. Lighter Limmie heifers sold to £925 with an over age Hereford selling to £940. 13 month Charolais's looked well sold at £900 with a run of 15 month Hereford heifers selling to £785.
