A respectable entry of calves maintaining a fair trade. Premium was given for those better reared calves along with all types of bull calves. Heifer calves were harder work. A & EE Saunders topped the section with their cracking Limmie bull calf reaching £255. Charolais bull calf from Dewi Williams sold close behind at £250. BB bulls from Davies, Gwardafolog, sold to £230 with others from Williams, Black Oak, to £210. Hereford Bulls from our Gwawr sold to £195. A strong Angus bull from Jones, Gorlan, got to £162.

BB heifers hit £190 from Messrs Jones with other BB heifers from Black Oak to £180. A Limmie heifer calf from Messrs Jones again, sold to £170. A Charolais heifer from AH Davies made £165 and Gwawr showed her Hereford heifer to £150.

Friesian bull kept firing with a ruck of excellent calves from IW Morgan selling to a top of £105. Processing calves were a run from £40-£70.
