Lower calf numbers this week with farmers making use of the good weather at home. However, the calves forward were a credit to our vendors with some tremendous individual calves penned up. Chetwynd Farms showed an excellent run of 3week old BB bulls to £345 with others to £325. Strong Lim bulls topped at £325 from George Pantiauau with others from the same home getting to £290. All the higher end bulls were £250 plus with plenty of customers there to buy. Younger Hereford calves sold to £180 with others to £172 from Thomas Nantygelly.

Heifer calves followed the bull calf trade with a cracking BB selling to £330 from Harries, Maesnonni. Chetwynd Farms had a run of BB's to £325 with their best limmie selling to £275. Other well reared Limme heifers from George, Pantiauau sold to £255 and Herefords from Thomas Nantyrlochfa sold to £180 with Owen & Co Pantygwiail sellinh theirs to £170. Welsh Black heifers to £170 from Harries Maesnonni and young AA to £85 from Phillips Corner Farm.

A nice selection of 30 weaned calves forward and a fast trade on all types. Jones, Gillo Fawr topping the trade with 9month old BB steers to £530. Other BB steers to £460 from Llewelyn Ashgrove. Hereford steers to £445 and 9month AA to £420 from Jones, Gillo.
