For future reference, we will not transfer ownership of livestock unless the person who will receive payment has completed and signed a movement licence/market entry form in full, explicitly denoting to whom payment should be made. This will be in line with the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA) regulation which prevents money laundering.

CATTLE VENDORS

Please note, Market Movement Forms including Food Chain Information details MUST be fully completed prior to presenting stock for sale and should include TB test dates and Farm Assurance (FAWL) details.

Cattle with no or incorrect FAWL details will be sold as non-assured, as will cattle with no forms.

Your assistance in this matter will help our office staff provide the correct information to buyers.
