A few more cattle forward as combining is almost complete and rain stopped play! With the major player threatening further price drops – the live auction continues to beat the trend with all the independent mean men around our ring prepared to give fair price for the sorts they want.

Steers in short supply and sold well to 226p/kg or £1464.48 in the lump/ More well fleshed bullocks required each week.

Best Heifers were a fair trade throughout selling to 249p/kg with several others in the 240p/kg prices. Heavier heifers sold to £1332.80.

A little more bite in the bull trade although definitely not on fire. Best Continentals sold to 211p/kg, with 6 over 200p/kg. Black and White bulls held their own with no square Friesians forward selling just short of 170p/kg.

Trade up around £5 per head, with commercial Texels from Gerry Davies to £99 twice, Suffolks £87 and Cheviots £85. Leaner ewes still dearer than the thicker overfat ewes. Plenty of Suffolk x Mules £80 to £87 with the plainer ewes looking very well sold. Mules to £68, smaller leaner mule 'types' at £55. The overall average would look similar to last week but would not show the full picture every other pen being small hill ewes.

Meat sold to £47, Welsh Swales £36, Small Scotch £35 and plainer ewes around £25 to £30 for Welsh. 9 Rams averages £90 selling to £110, Suffolk £107, Beltex and Texel £100, 'Working' Texels at £87 and Exlana £79.

A smaller entry in this week but trade was holding firm seeing half a dozen Black Silkie hatching eggs sell for £4.50. Old English Game hatching eggs sold to £2.50 for half a dozen and Shetland Duck Eggs and Wheaten Aracana realised £2 for the same number.

Very small number of birds forward but despite this a strong trade was seen. Cockerels sold to £6.50 with a Brahma Cockerel to £8. Gold Silkie Bantams saw a terrific trade to £11 each.

Guinea Fowl Keets and Silkie Chicks all sold to £3 per bird with other Bantam chicks to £2. Indian Runner Ducklings sold to £5 with a further variety of stock also seen.

A good entry of rabbits saw Lin Head Does and Bucks sell to £10 with Guinea Pigs selling to £5 each
