A few less cattle forward, especially in the bull department, saw trade holding up well as long as the cattle were well fleshed. There were some great heifers penned this morning and there was plenty of competition on these. Many steers would have benefitted for a little more time on the hopper.

Reasonable steer numbers forward saw the best available selling to 229p/kg or £1470 in the lump. Well finished steers are wanted!

More heifers could have easily sold this market, with best butcher's heifers selling to a high of 267p/kg with 6 cattle 260p/kg or more. 9 others sold to 250p/kg – 259p/kg. Heavy females sold to £1410 in the lump.

Several good quality bulls forward saw real shape and meat selling to 231p/kg with heavy Continentals to £1531.20 in the lump. More Friesian Holsteins were needed today selling to 179p/kg.

17 STEERS FORWARD SOLD TO OV. AV. 190P/KG

A 642kg Blonde steer from Mrs 'B' was an early riser to achieve 229p/kg or £1470.18 in the lump. Simmental crosses from John Cantrill sold to 206p/kg for 592kg, with Mike Evans selling two Charolais crosses to 204p/kg. Dave and Brian Whiteman's Limousin cross hit 200p/kg for 576kg.

68 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 218P/KG

Starring Limmies from Steve Perkins headed this department and overall top price at 267p/kg for 494kg, with a similar heifer to 260p/kg. 500kg Limmies from Andrew Bishop sold to 266p/kg with his second best heifer to 260p/kg for 520kg. Evans (Curdale) sold nicely to 261p/kg for 528kg, with 506kg from Richard Parkes selling to 260p/kg. 600kg Limousins stacked up to £1410 from Dave Preece.

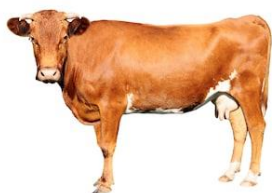
