148 PRIME CATTLE

Good numbers of clean cattle forward met strong demand with all well fleshed cattle easiest sold. There is a marked deficit of bulls at the moment, with orders leaving only partially filled today. Several plainer sorts and overagers are included in the averages.

A decent sample of steers met a roaring trade, with two Continentals selling to 246p/kg and to £1,606 in the lump.

Some great heifers forward once again missed the heady heights of last week by one penny! Consequently, 295p/kg was top price with 6 steers 270p/kg and above. Heavy females sold to £1,592 in the lump, with all well finished, well presented cattle seeing a great trade.

The shortage of bulls continues with very few best types forward. A top price of 225p/kg was achieved or £1,574 in the lump. Holstein Friesians met a fiery trade selling to 198p/kg on two occasions, with anything with a 'lick' of meat easy to sell.

17 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 203P/KG

A sharp trade throughout with the average depleted by overage longhorns etc. Roger Jordin and Frank Davenport were both on the podium with their Limmies at 246p/kg for 582kg and 588kg respectively, with the Jordin's also selling Charolais to 244p/kg or £1,605.52 in the lump. 594kg Limousins from the Dalton stable hit 240p/kg, with John Rogers and Mrs B both selling to 237p/kg for their best steers.

94 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 225P/KG

The level of demand was exceptional here once again, with a great run of Limousins from Evans Curdale well rewarded achieving 6 of the top ten prices to 295p/kg for 534kg with others 288p/kg, 286p/kg, 280p/kg, 270p/kg & 267p/kg. Richard Parkes starring heifer sold to 278p/kg for 536kg. Very shapey but ultra lean blues sold to 267p/kg at 576kg from Mrs B. The Curdale gang were headlining again selling their heavier 642kg Limmie to £1,592.16 with Mrs B selling to £1,549.80 for 630kg.

37 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 189P/KG

Mainly Holstein Friesians forward this morning saw a fantastic return. Richard Skellern's single Limousin sold to 225p/kg for 598kg, with two nice sorts to 224p/kg from the Daltons and Mark Jones. Heavy limmies sold to £1,573.20 at 760kg from Dickie Price. The Black & White trade was as dear as ever selling to 198p/kg from Andrew Maiden and Steve Howells. 50 plus bulls needed each week please.

With numbers of ewes very short in most areas, numbers are being maintained at Bridgnorth, in fact, they are up on the corresponding weeks last year ensuring a constant supply for customers.

Trade very similar to last week although heavy ewes most sought after with no pure bred ewes forward, cross bred Texels topped the sale at £122.50 from John Cantrill and 30 rams to £133 for a strong Texel from John Heighway.

Suffolk x Mules sold to £121 from P Wilcox with Romneys £102, large North Country Mules £97 with lighter but leaner Mules £90. Large lean ewes most definitely the order of the day with what might be described as plain ewes selling extremely well. Pen after pen of hill ewes sold to £74.50 EasyCare, with plainer EasyCare £70, Scotch Blackface £75 and half meated Blackies £60. Plenty of Swales at £50 to £55 with real kippers at £40, small Welsh Mountain at £34.50.

Rams sold to £133 Texels, £124 Suffolk, £108 Beltex, £94 BFL and Swale rams £70.

Considering numbers of hogs seem to be quite tight in local markets, remarkably over 2000 were penned this week of all sizes, shapes and quality.

Trade held throughout the sale, although as everywhere, on Tuesday for the first time for 12 months it would be a little easier or at least the pressure of previous weeks would be off. An overall average of 280p/kg including several runs of 30 to 37kg hogs.

Ed Bunning took top spot with Beltex at 312p/kg, with best hogs few and far between and the top price per head of £149 for the last pen of the day from Richard Morgan.

Trade on hogs under 40kg would compare with anywhere with 33½kg Beltex from Mark Steele at 299p/kg and several from Dave Green and Ian Morris 290p/kg to 296p/kg, with more commercial 36kg hogs 280p/kg to 290p/kg.

Export weights 40kg to 44kg a similar trade to last week but hogs 45kg to 48kg would see the most change in trade, whereas 46kg hogs in past weeks would be clocking up the highest prices per head this week a 43kg hogg would amount to more than a 45kg hogg. Heavy weights generally around £125 to £130, notably tup lambs 52kg at £132 and 46kg 284p/kg from GH Davies Holdings Ltd Shrewsbury.
