107 PRIME CATTLE

A great show of clean cattle but once again the bull deficit continues. Trade was nothing short of fantastic, with cattle selling above 280p/kg once again. Any cattle with meat were in strong demand even if they lacked shape at times. Our advice is to sell whilst the cattle are wanted.

Only a small show of steers penned this morning saw best shapes to 258p/kg, with heavies to £1604 for 674kg Continentals.

A blistering heifer market selling to 281p/kg for half ton butchers Limousins, with plenty over 270p/kg including heifers over 600kg adding up nicely to £1600 plus.

Disappointing bull numbers once again, with some orders not getting started. Best shapes were few and far between selling to 235p/kg. No heavy best bulls forward with £1423 Limousin cross top price per head. Black & whites in strong demand to 196p/kg. Many more bulls required each week.

74 CLEAN CATTLE

ONLY 11 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 206P/KG

Sharp Limmies from Evans (Curdale) topped here at 258p/kg for 542kg, with heavy Limousins 674kg to 238p/kg (£1604.12) from Matt & Wendy Bower. Limousin crosses from Terry Bebb sold well to £1432.44 for 692kg and Hereford steers to 175p/kg from John Westwood at 664kg.

63 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 229P/KG

Several storming performances in this section, with Richard Parkes headlining at 281p/kg for 494kg, with others to 279, 277 (x2) and 273p/kg. 500kg Limmies from Evans (Curdale) once again sailed to 279p/kg. 602kg black homebred Lims from Robert Morris started out at 270p/kg for 602kg £1625.40, with another star from Andrew Bishop selling 656kg Blues to £1633.44. A nice run from 'Mrs B' topped out at 269p/kg for 564kg Limmie, with 486kg from Charlie Sandells achieving 264p/kg.

ONLY 23 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV 185P/KG

Mainly dairy bred bulls forward today with everything well rewarded. Tom & Brian Lloyd sold their homebred Limmies to 227p/kg and 226p/kg for 598kg and 630kg respectively, but with Robert Morris doing well again at 235p/kg for 568kg Lims. Tom Hill sold his Limousin crosses to 207p/kg with Mark Lloyd's young Holstein Friesians selling to 190p/kg at 13months of age.

A very firm trade for the lambs forward averaging 220p/kg and £113.05, with all the lambs over 39kg averaging just over £100 per head.

Best butchers lambs very dear to 265p/kg for 43kg Texels from Andrew Meredith and plenty 240p/kg plus, notably 238p/kg for 47.5kg from Pete Morris. Commercial lambs 38kg to 43kg attracting 'spirited' bidding with the export trade seemingly very busy. Heavier lambs over 50kg possibly a little easier than last week, with most just on or over £2/kg except those very heavy lambs at £100 per head. Lightweights under 35kg desperately short and very dear with Welsh mountain complete with long tails, horns and entire over £2/kg and 34kg Charollais x lambs at 220p/kg.

More lambs required for next week, 2000 plus lambs could easily be sold every Tuesday without any effect on trade.
